



Scholarship Application

The **Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Breakfast Committee Scholarship**, administered by the Annapolis & Anne Arundel County Scholarship Trust, is available to graduating Anne Arundel County high school seniors with a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. Applicants should be able to show a demonstrated commitment to social justice, community service, leadership, or cultural awareness experiences and be considering a full-time college education as an incoming freshman in the fall of 2016. The scholarship will be awarded for a period of four years or the length of the course, up to a maximum of \$800.00 per semester/\$6,400.00 for four years. The scholarship will also include a mentor and access to the Annapolis Trust's Mentor Network for the length of the student's enrollment. Recipients must maintain certain standards as noted in their Annual Student Agreement and continuous enrollment.

- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Interviews will be conducted as part of the decision making process.
- The successful applicant will be announced no later than April 15, 2016.
- The scholarship will be granted for the upcoming school year beginning in August or September 2016.
- Applicants will be notified by mail of the scholarship award.
- Upon award of a scholarship, recipient must send proof of admission to a regionally accredited college or university and a schedule of classes to show proof of enrollment to the Annapolis Trust.
- The recipient must maintain a Grade Point Average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale to maintain the scholarship.
- The Scholarship Review Committee's (with members from the Annapolis Trust and the MLK Breakfast Committee) decision is final.
